Dear Sir,

I am writing in reply to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act as follows:

1. List of Department of Justice owned or rented premises, including: Location, Year of construction, Total square footage, Primary use/function, Number of employees per site (if applicable), and teams/departments housed within each premises.

The DoJ Core is located in three buildings across the Stormont Estate, all of which are owned by the Department of Finance (DoF), as set out in the table below:

The Department owns the following premises:

- Maryfield located at 100 Belfast Road, Holywood Co. Down BT18 9QY.
- The year of construction for these premises was 1989; and
- The total square footage is 2,817m².
- These premises are leased to an ALB of the department; the Police Rehabilitation and Retraining Trust.
- Department does not hold any information on the number of employees of this site and/or what teams are housed within these premises.

If you are unhappy with the result of your request for information you may request an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this letter. If you request an internal review please do so in writing stating the reasons to the address above.

If following an internal review you were to remain dissatisfied you may make a complaint to the Information Commissioner and ask him to investigate whether the DOJ has complied with the terms of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004. You can write to the Information Commissioner at:
