Thank you for your request for information dated 15 September 2024 in which you requested the following information:

*From 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2019 onwards, please provide details of spending on any and all grants, funding and payments from all and any funding sources to Rangers F.C. Supporters Clubs, defined as any club with the term “Rangers F.C. Supporters Club” or similar in its name (either its registered name or trading name), which could reasonably be construed to be a club formed with the primary purpose of supporting Rangers F.C. of Glasgow.*

*Please provide a full breakdown with dates of the relevant spending, spending by year, and please specify what clubs were in receipt of funding, how much funding they each received, and explanations of the purpose of this spending.*

*Furthermore, please explain to what extent your policy or actions (be it related to funding or otherwise) have either provided for, or restricted, or otherwise regulated or concerned, the funding of Rangers F.C. Supporters Clubs; and please advise of the history of your policy and actions on this matter and any changes to your policy.*

*In particular, please advise of funding in respect of Rangers F.C. Supporters Clubs, and policy concerning the promotion of such clubs (including at your events/premises), and how this policy has changed over time.*

*Please also provide copies of any correspondence between you and Rangers F.C. Supporters Clubs, or between you and individuals acting in capacity as representatives of Rangers F.C. Supporters Clubs, or indeed between you and Rangers F.C. itself.*

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 gives you two rights of access when you write to us asking for information. You have the right to know whether we hold recorded

information falling in scope of your request and you have the right to receive this recorded information subject to cost limit or exemption.

The Department does not hold any information within the scope of your request.

If you are unhappy with the result of your request for information you may request an internal review within two calendar months of the date of this letter. If you request an internal review please do so in writing stating the reasons to the address above.

If following an internal review you were to remain dissatisfied you may make a complaint to the Information Commissioner and ask the Commissioner to investigate whether the DOJ has complied with the terms of the FOIA. You can write to the Information Commissioner at:
