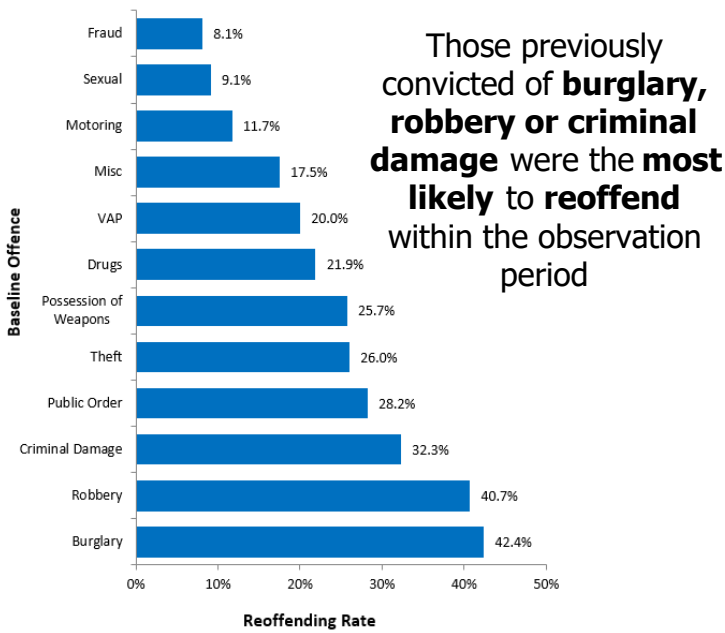
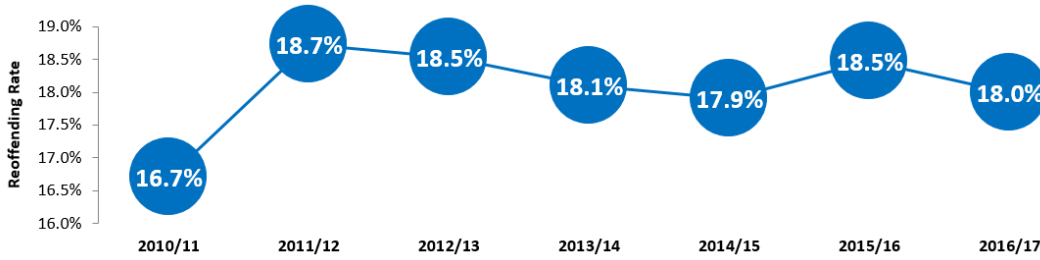
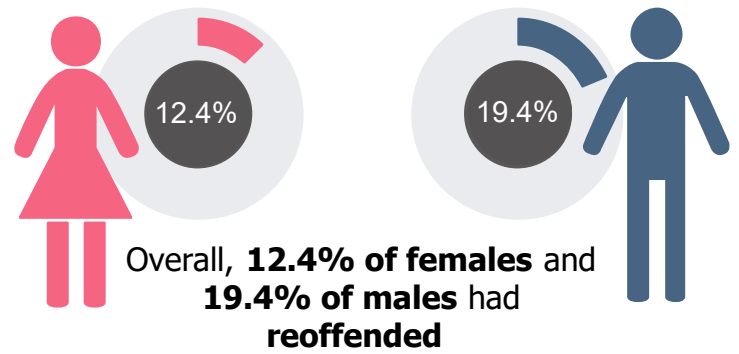


Of the 21,493 people included in the 2016/17 cohort, **3,862 (18.0%) reoffended** during the one year observational period

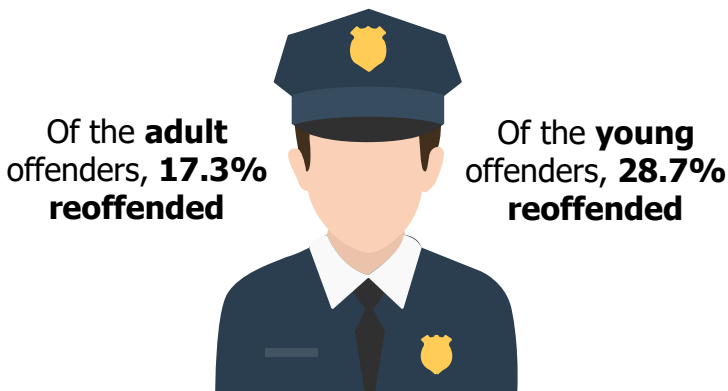
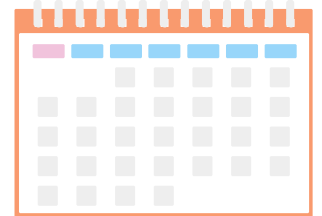
The overall reoffending rate is being used as an indicator for the **Draft Programme for Government** and the **NICS Outcomes Delivery Plan**



Those previously convicted of **burglary, robbery or criminal damage** were the most likely to reoffend within the observation period



Of the reoffenders, **over two-fifths (43.7%)** committed their **first reoffence** within the first **three months**



In terms of offending history, **61.3% of the 21,493 had committed previous offences** ranging from one to 590 distinct offences
