

Views on Alcohol and Drug Related Issues: Findings from the October 2016 NI Omnibus Survey

43% of respondents felt concerned by alcohol related issues in their local area

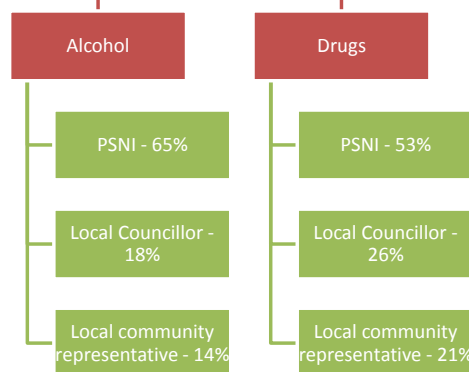
9% of respondents said they had been affected by alcohol related issues in their local area



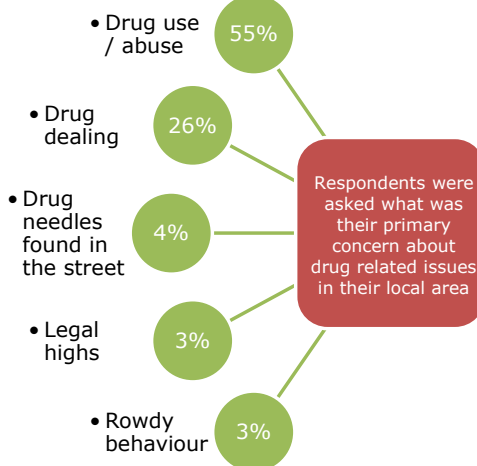
Four fifths of respondents stated there was no change in either the level of alcohol related issues (83%) or drug related issues (80%) in their local area in the last 12 months



Bodies / Representative approached in the last 12 months to report an issue in their local area



57% of respondents thought the main harm caused by alcohol/drugs related issues in their area was anti-social behaviour



43% of respondents felt concerned by drug related issues in their local area

5% of respondents said they had been affected by drug related issues in their local area

Over half of respondents (53%) expressed some, a lot or total confidence that enough is being done to tackle alcohol/drug related issues across Northern Ireland



This figure is down compared the the 57% reported from the 2012 survey

The PSNI had the highest confidence rating (76%), followed by PCSPs (67%)
