Thank you for your request for information dated 2nd March 2022 and detailed below:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, I would like to request details of the department's unused, vacant or derelict land and property.

Please disclose a list of the land and property the department owns which are unused, vacant or derelict. For each please include:

- A brief description of the land or property, including if available its area size (i.e. acreage, square footage or whatever units of measurement you have).*
- It's address.*
- In each year from 2020 to present, the maintenance costs to secure and/or maintain the land or property.*

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 gives you two rights of access when you write to us asking for information. You have the right to know whether we hold recorded information falling in scope of your request, and you have the right to receive this recorded information subject to cost limit or exemption.

In relation to the information you have requested, please be advised that Department of Justice currently has one vacant property, namely NI War Rooms (Former) situated in Mount Eden Park, Belfast. The site is 0.64 acres (0.25899 hectares) and was previously used as a document store for the Department. It is however currently surplus to requirement.



The maintenance cost for the financial year 2019-20 (from when the property was vacated) was £3,435 and for the 2020-21 financial year the maintenance cost was £6,024.

If you are unhappy with the result of your request for information you may request an internal review within two calendar months of the date of this letter. If you request an internal review, please do so in writing stating the reasons to the address above.

If following an internal review, you were to remain dissatisfied you may make a complaint to the Information Commissioner and ask the Commissioner to investigate whether the DOJ has complied with the terms of the FOIA. You can write to the Information Commissioner at:
