Thank you for your request for information dated 02 August 2023 and detailed below.

- i) How much funding has been allocated by the Department of Justice to the Northern Ireland Courts and Tribunals Service to implement the recommendations of the Gillen Review, per year, since 2019?**
- ii) How much funding has been allocated by the Department of Justice to the PPS to implement the recommendations of the Gillen Review, per year, since 2019?**

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 gives you two rights of access when you write to us asking for information. You have the right to know whether we hold recorded information in scope of your request, and you have the right to have that recorded information given to you. These rights may only be overridden if the information you are looking for is covered by an exemption in the Act.
